Peace

Be still and know that I am God! Psalm 46:10

Peace in the midst of a storm. Have you ever experienced this? The psalmist reminds us of the peace that comes from knowing God. He reminds those who would sing and read these words for many generations that God is our refuge, our strength, and a present help. Because God is who He is, we will not fear.

The description of natural disasters and the disasters of war are used to recount many of the ways that we are tempted to lose heart. The threat of death, disease, and pain is certainly the things that make the elements of a horror movie and are pictures of horrific events that are common among the generations. We experience many of these same things today. How are we to respond?

Some people will cower in a corner hoping that the storm will not impact their lives. Others will rush headlong toward the problem thinking that in their own strength they will overcome the obstacle. While the storm may pass from either response, what God wants us to know is that He is still in control.

When we have no place of shelter, He is our refuge. When we have wrestled with the issue until we grow faint, He is our strength. When we have looked everywhere for help, we only have to look up and know He is present.

Storms come and storms go, but the steadfast love of the Lord is our constant companion. That's why the psalmist can say, "Be still" or another translation of the word is cease striving, relax. We can relax because we know that He is God. Better still, we can know He is our God. Have faith. Don't give up. Hang on. The God who made the waters can speak and the waves that are crashing will become calm. Peace is on the way. Do not fear.
